1. **RECORDS:** [Section 25 (1) of Annex to the Bylaws]

2. **PHARMACY:** [Section 25 (1) of Annex to the Bylaws]

(a) Are compartments provided for the storage, safekeeping and preparation of drugs in accordance with federal and provincial laws? Y N

(a) Are dated, initialed and autoclaved packs available for major surgery in the field? Y N

Note: It is recommended that cap, mask, sterile gown and gloves be worn for major surgery in large animals, but are mandatory for bone and joint surgery.

(a) Are readily available restraint devices provided for the safety of animals and personnel? Y N
